when at school and at home.
- Stay involved and informed by checking the website and reading communications sent home.
- Ask your child if he/she received any BEAR Bucks this week. Give positive feedback when they have earned bucks!



Managing BEEhaviors

The whole school will be using the same BEEhavior plan that will provide students with consistency throughout the building. Each classroom has the same BEEhavior chart. Each day, every student will start out on the chart on "Ready to Learn" They will be able to stay at "Ready to Learn" or move up to "Caught BEEing Great!" if they show exceptional behaviors. Students who are not following the expectations may also move down the chart.

If a student consistently does not follow the expectations, you will be notified regarding the behaviors and the consequence given. If violations continue or a serious violation occurs, then a student may receive an office referral. Students may also earn several positive rewards for meeting and exceeding BEEhavior expectations such as Bear Bucks to spend at the Bear Bucks store, raffle prizes, special passes (no homework or Speed Pass to the front of a line). Good BEEhavior can also grant your child access to special monthly events at school!

Mayfair's proactive approach to student discipline and behavior management called Positive Behavior Intervention Support, or **PBIS** for short.

PBIS focuses on teaching and supporting positive behavior of all students. PBIS also helps create safe learning environments where students are able to learn, and teachers are able to teach.

PBIS is meant to recognize the positive behaviors of all students, acknowledge and reinforce the students for exhibiting the appropriate behaviors, and provide support to those students who need extra guidance meeting school-wide expectations.

All student's are expected to come to school ready to follow the Three BEEs expectations each day.

Special activities for teaching and celebrating the demonstration of these expectations will occur throughout the year.

BEAR Bucks/Tickets

During the school day students will have the opportunity to earn a positive "**BEAR Bucks/Tickets**" when exhibiting exemplary behavior. These behaviors could be observed by staff members in the classroom, hallway, cafeteria, bathroom, playground, or in any other area of the school. A drawing will be held at least once a week in each classroom to recognize and reinforce these positive behaviors.

The BEARS Three BEES expectations were developed by the teachers and staff at Mayfair Elementary. All teachers and staff are trained on PBIS and will help support student learning by reinforcing positive behaviors and supporting students through positive behavioral interventions.
