



AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY – Includes courses in Ground Transportation Maintenance, Automotive Braking/Suspensions & Steering Systems, Ground Transportation Electrical/Electronics, and Ground Transportation Engine/Power Train which provides students with the learning and skills necessary to diagnose, adjust, repair, and replace mechanical and electrical parts of an automobile as well as provide a pathway for entry level employment or post high school education in the field of Automotive Technology. All students completing this course and passing the state assessment will be geared towards as ASE (Automotive Service Excellence) certification and are eligible to receive articulated college credits upon graduation.
