



EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION – Students are prepared for paid employment in Early Childhood care and guidance. It includes courses in Early Childhood Education Principles, Classroom Management, Curriculum & Institution for Early Childhood Education, Health Safety and Nutrition. The program includes instruction and experience to develop competencies in teaching and guiding young children. Students are eligible to receive their First Aid/CPR and Domestic Violence/Child Abuse & Neglect certifications. Additionally, students successfully completing the program will be eligible to receive the National Child Development Associates credential and are eligible to receive articulated college credits upon graduation.
