



**NURSE ASSISTING** – Includes courses on Health Science Technology and Nutrition/Wellness where students in this program will learn basic health care skills, such as taking vital signs, measuring height and weight, administering medications, infection control, patient care, vision screening, and medical office procedures. The students successfully completing this course and successfully passing the state administered examination will receive the State Tested Nurses Assistant (S.T.N.A.) certification. Students are also eligible to receive their First Aid/CPR and Domestic Violence/Child Abuse & Neglect certifications. Successful program completers are eligible to receive articulated college credits upon graduation.
