Prospect Academy provides a nurturing environment that is designed to foster early learning, preparing our youngest learners for kindergarten and beyond.


Through the use of the "creative curriculum", Prospect Academy provides equal opportunities for all students. This is a place where students can explore a world where learning meets fun.





At Kirk, our commitment extends beyond our students. Parent Empowerment Coaches are here to assist families with utilities and accessing community resources, ensuring every family feels supported.


