1. RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH AND PAYMENT TO THERAPIA STAFFING

WHEREAS, this agreement is made between Therapia Staffing (TS) and the East Cleveland City School District to provide District Wide Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL) services for the 2019-2020 school year.

WHEREAS, compensation for services provided by Therapia Staffing, at an hourly bill rate of \$65.00 per hour for said services provided during the 2019-2020 fiscal year; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District accepts the 2019-2020 Therapia Staffing Service Agreement and enters into said agreement with Therapia Staffing, and further be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the Treasurer to encumber and pay an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00 for said services from the General Fund-001.

2. RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT THE EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTER OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY INTER-DISTRICT SERVICE AREA CONTRACT

WHEREAS, a contract entered into between the East Cleveland City School District Board of Education and the Governing Board of the Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County (ESCCC) in consideration of the promises and terms contained and pursuant to the provisions of Section 3313.17, 3313.841,3313.842, 3313.91, and 3323.08 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, the Board of the ESCCC shall invoice the Service Area for all net costs related (not covered by state and federal funds) to the employment of the personnel specified herein, and

WHEREAS, the Service Area accepts the responsibility of conducting annual evaluation (s) of administrative, classified and certified employees, who are not evaluated by the ESCCC as defined in a prior agreement between Service Area and ESCCC administration pursuant to Section 3319.01, 3319.02, 3319.11 and 3319.111 of the Ohio Revised Code; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District accepts the 2019-2020 Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County Inter-District Service Area Agreement and enters into said agreement with the Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County, and further be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the Treasurer to encumber and pay funds in the amount of said net cost indicated in the contract.

3. RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH AND PAYMENT TO RUTH DAVIDSON-GORDON

WHEREAS, the East Cleveland City School District will contract with Ruth Davidson-Gordon to provide one hundred twenty (120) hours of instruction to Culinary Arts, Early Childhood Education, and Health Science students for their certification course in Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED for the 2019-2020 school year at a cost of \$3,550.00; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the Treasurer to encumber and pay an amount not to exceed \$3,550.00 for said services from the Career-Technical General Fund-001.

4. RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE A CONTRACT WITH AND PAYMENT TO ANDRE F. HAYNESWORTH

WHEREAS, the East Cleveland City School District will contract with Andre F. Haynesworth to provide instruction and classroom/lab technical assistance with Report Writing, and Homeland Security Training for Shaw High Criminal Justice juniors and Private Security Instruction for Criminal Justice seniors for the 2019-2020 school year; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the Treasurer to encumber and pay an amount not to exceed \$19,240.00 for said services from the Carl Perkins Fund -524.

WHEREAS, the East Cleveland City School District is a member of the Ohio Schools Council Cooperative Bus Purchasing Program, and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Schools Council on behalf of the East Cleveland City School District received bids for the purchase of two school buses; one 72 passenger Special Needs Bus and one 65 passenger Conventional School bus, and

WHEREAS, Rush Truck Centers of Ohio, Inc. in Akron, Ohio was the successful bidder. Therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the purchase of one 72 passenger Special Needs Bus for the amount of \$45,000.00 and one 65 passenger Conventional School Bus for the amount of \$81,799.00, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the East Cleveland City School District authorizes the Treasurer to encumber an amount not to exceed \$126,790.00 from the Transportation Department FY20 budget. General Fund – 001 budget.
